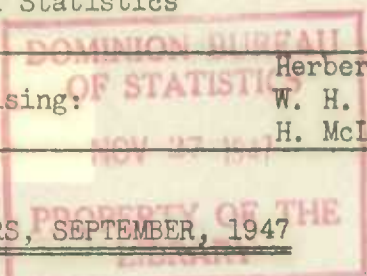

SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS, SEPTEMBER, 1947

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$5,586,300 in September, 1947 compared with \$5,806,373 in August, 1947. In September, 1947 the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 50 per cent of the total; industrial sales for 38 per cent; water paints for 3 per cent, and unclassified sales for 9 per cent.
