## SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

## OCTOBER - 1948

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian Production, amounted to $\$ 5,838,629$ in October, 1948, compared with $\$ 6,352,437$ in October, 1947. In Octover, 1948 the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 44 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 40 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, and unclassified sales for 14 per cent.
