SALES OF PAINTS, VARVISHES AND LACQUERS

NOVEMBER, 1948 (Corrected Statement)

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian Production, amounted to \$5,765,737 in November, 1948, compared with \$5,717,284 in November, 1947. In November, 1948 the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 45 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 40 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, and unclassified sales for 13 per cent.
