## SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LAC UUERS

## APRIL, 1948

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 8,683,762$ in April, 1948, compared with $\$ 7,627,837$ in March, 1948. In Apr11, 1948 the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 50 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 31 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, and unclassified sales for 17 per cent.
