

## GALES OF PAINTAS, VARUIISHES AND LACGUERS

JUNE, 1948
Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 8,369,928$ in June, 1948 , compared with $\$ 6,876,573$ in June, 1947. In June, 1948 the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 51 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 32 per cent, water paints for 2 per cont, and unclassified sales for 15 per cent.
