Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 6,786,676$ in July, 1948, compared with $\$ 5,777,486$ in July, 1947. In July, 1948 the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 49 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 36 per cent, water paints for 1 per cent, and unclassified sales for 14 per cent.
