## SALES OF PATNTS, VARNISHES AHD LAOQUPRS <br> September, 1948

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normaily account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian Production, amounted to $\$ 5,813,465$ in September, 1948, compared with $\$ 5,586,300$ in September, 1947. In September, 1948 the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 45 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 44 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, and unclassified sales for 9 per cent.
