Sales of painte, varnishas and lacquers by manufactirere, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canaajian production, amounted to $\$ 4,244,365$ in December, 1949 compared with $\$ 4,493,389$ in December, 1948. For the entire year 1949 the value of sales was $\$ 78,777,468$ a decline of 4 per cent from the corresponding total of $\$ 82,258,259$ in 1948.
