

## 2 RCH - 1949

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Cenadian production, amounted to $\$ 6,704,000$ in Narch, 1949, compared with $\$ 6,157,584$ in Fobruary. In liarch, 1949, the trade sales (exclusive of weter paints) accounted for about 51 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 36 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, and unclassified sales for 11 per cent.
