Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$6,342,492 in July, 1949, compared with \$8,722,179 in June, 1949. In July, 1949, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 50 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 35 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, and unclassified sales for 13 per cent.
