

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to $\$ 7,633,954$ in October 1950 compared with $\$ 6,039,078$ in 1949. In October 1950, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 47 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 39 per cent, water paints for 5 per cent, and unclassified sales for 9 per cent.
