Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to $\$ 6,574,705$ in December, 1950 compared with $4,244,365$ in 1949. In December, 1950 , the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 48 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 38 per cent, water paints for 3 per cent, and unclassified sales for 10 per cent.
