Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to $\$ 7,117,029$ in April, 1950 compared with $\$ 6,439,580$ in March. In April, 1950 the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 56 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 34 per cent, water paints for 6 per cent, and unclassified sales for 4 per cent.
