



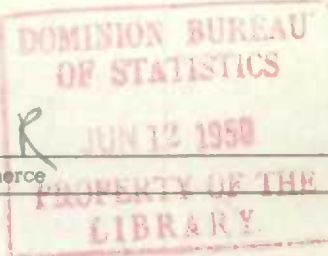

SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERSAPRIL, 1950

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to \$7,117,029 in April, 1950 compared with \$6,439,580 in March. In April, 1950 the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 56 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 34 per cent, water paints for 6 per cent, and unclassified sales for 4 per cent.
