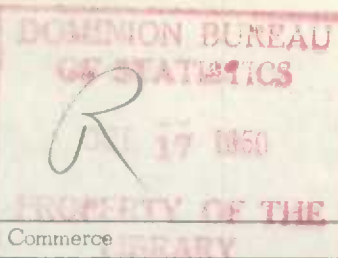

SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERSAUGUST - 1950

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to \$8,656,676 in August, 1950 compared with \$6,818,867 in 1949. In August, 1950, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 55 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 32 per cent, water paints for 4 per cent, and unclassified sales for 9 per cent.
