Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to $\$ 6,426,483$ in November, 1951 compared with $; 7,360,803$ in November, 1950. The trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 49 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 41 per cent, water paints for 7 per cent, and unclassified sales for 3 per cent, in November, 1951.
