SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

DECEMBER - 1951

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to \$5,258,235 in December, 1951 compared with \$6,574,705 in December 1950. The trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 49 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 41 per cent, water paints for 7 per cent, and unclassified sales for 3 per cent, in December 1951.
