## MAY - 1951

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to \$10,515,218 in May, 1951 compared with \$8,696,114 in May, 1950. The trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 53 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 36 per cent, water paints for 4 per cent, and unclassified sales for 7 per cent, in May, 1951.
