## SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

## JUNE - 1951

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to $\$ 10,100,630$ in June, 1951 compared with $\$ 9,272,246$ in June, 1950. The trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 52 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 37 per cent, water paints for 3 per cent, and unclassified sales for 8 per cent, in June, 1951.
