SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERSAUGUST - 1951

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to \$8,030,694 in August, 1951 compared with \$8,650,196 in August, 1950. The trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 53 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 38 per cent, water paints for 4 per cent, and unclassified sales for 5 per cent, in August, 1951.
