## SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

## SEPTEMBER - 1951

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to \$6,874,045 in September, 1951 compared with \$7,927,356 in September, 1950. The trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 49 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 42 per cent, water paints for 6 per cent, and unclassified sales for 3 per cent, in September, 1951.
