SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

NOVEMBER, 1952

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to \$7,483,544 in November, 1952, compared with \$6,426,483 in 1951. In November, 1952, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 48 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 40 per cent, water paints for 9 per cent, and unclassified sales for 3 per cent.
