## SALES CF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

## NOVEMBER, 1952

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which nomally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to ${ }^{\text {W }} 7,483,544$ in November, 1952, compered with $\$ 6,426,483$ in 1951. In November, 1952, the trade seles (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 48 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 40 per cent, water paints for 9 per cent, and unclassified sales for 3 per cent.
