SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

DECEMBER - 1952

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to \$6,462,175 in December, 1952, compared with \$5,258,235 in 1951. In December, 1952, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 45 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 44 per cent, water paints for 8 per cent, and unclassified sales for 3 per cent.
