## SALES OE PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

## DECEITBER - 1952

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to $\$ 6,462,175$ in December, 1952, compared mith $\$ 5,258,235$ in 1951. In Decomber, 1952, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 45 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 44 per cent, water paints for 8 per cent, and unclassified sales for 3 per cent.
