## SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS <br> FGBRUARY - 1952

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to $\$ 7,482,921$ in February, 1952 compared with $\$ 7,618,290$ in 1951. In February, 1952, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 52 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 38 per cent, water paints for 7 per cent, and unclassified sales for 3 per cent.
