## SALES UF PAINTS, VARNIS!ES AND LACQUERS

## MARCH - 1952

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to $\$ 0,280,084 \mathrm{in} \mathrm{March}, \mathrm{1952}$, comparel with $\$ 8,171,505$ in 1951. In March, 1952, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accountel for about 50 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 36 per cent, water paints for 9 per cent, and unclassified sales for 5 per cent.
