## SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHRS AND LACQUERS

APRIL - 1952

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to $\$ 10,190,704$ in April 1952, compared with $\$ 9,749,307$ in 1951. In April, 1952, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 52 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 33 per cent, water paints for 9 per cent, and unclassified sales for 6 per cent.
