## MAY - 1952

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to $\$ 11,242,968$ in May, 1952 , compared with $\$ 10,515,218$ in 1951. In May, 1952, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 54 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 32 per cent, water paints for 7 per cent, and unclasaified sales for 7 per cent.
