SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

MAY - 1952

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to \$11,242,968 in May, 1952, compared with \$10,515,218 in 1951. In May, 1952, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 54 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 32 per cent, water paints for 7 per cent, and unclassified sales for 7 per cent.
