## SALES OF PAINTS VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to $\$ 10,827,084$ in June, 1952, compared with $\$ 10,100,630$ in 1951. In June, 1952, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 52 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 33 per cent, water paints for 6 per cent, and unclassified sales for 9 per cent.
