## SALES OF PAINTS YARNISHES AND LACQUERS

## JULX - 1252

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to $\$ 9,321,712$ in July, 1952, compared with $\$ 8,695,562$ in 1951. In July, 1952, the trade sales (oxclusivo of water paints) accounted for about 54 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 34 per cent, water paints for 5 per cent, and unclassified sales for 7 per cent.
