## SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

AUGUST - 1952

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to $\$ 8,791,365$ in August, 1952, compared with $\$ 8,030,694$ in 1951. In August, 1952, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 52 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 35 per cent, water paints for 7 per cent, and unclassified sales for 6 per cent.
