SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERSAUGUST - 1952

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to \$8,791,365 in August, 1952, compared with \$8,030,694 in 1951. In August, 1952, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 52 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 35 per cent, water paints for 7 per cent, and unclassified sales for 6 per cent.
