Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to \$8,331,262 in September, 1952, compared with \$6,874,045 in 1951. In September, 1952, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 49 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 40 per cent, water paints for 7 per cent, and unclassified sales for 4 per cent.
