## SATES OF PAIIVIS, VARIIISIES AND LACQUERS

## OCTOBER - 1953

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 8,421,886$ in October, 1953, compared with $\$ 8,230,597$ in 1952. In October, 1953, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 50 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 36 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, latex emulsion for 9 per cent and unclassified sales for 3 per cent.
