Saies of paints, vernishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the totai Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 10,928,175$ in April, 1953, compared with $\$ 10,177,995$ in 1952. In April, 1953, the trade sales (exclusive of water paint.) accounted for about. 4 ? per cent of the total, industrial sales for 34 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, latex emulsion for 9 per cent, and unclassified sales for 6 per cent.
