SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

APRIL - 1953

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$10,928,175 in April, 1953, compared with \$10,177,995 an 1952. In April, 1953, the trade sales (exclusive of water paint.) accounted for about 49 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 34 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, latex emulsion for 9 per cent, and unclassified sales for 6 per cent.
