Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, winc Porpartereppht for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to $111,309,466$ in inay, 1959, compared With $\$ 11,230,259$ in 1952. In May, 1953, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 5 ? per cent of the total, industrial salos for 32 per cent, water paints for 2 por cent, latex emulsion for 8 per cent, and unclassified sales for 6 per cent.
