Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$11,309,466 in May, 1953, compared with \$11,230,259 in 1952. In May, 1953, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 52 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 32 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, latex emulsion for 8 per cent, and unclassified sales for 6 per cent.
