## SALES OF PAIMTS, VARIISIES AND LACQUERS <br> June - 1953

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 11,556,408$ in June, 1953, compared with $\$ 10,809,932$ in 1952. In June, 1953, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 53 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 34 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, latex enulsion for 6 per cent, and unclassified sales for 5 per cent.
