## SAIES OF PAINIS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

## July - 1253

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 10,418,598$ in $\$ 4 / y, 1953$, compared with $\$ 9,304,560$ in 1952. In July, 1953, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 53 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 36 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, latex emulsion for 4 per cent, and unclassified sales for 5 per cent.
