SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

July - 1953

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$10,418,598 in July, 1953, compared with \$9,304,560 in 1952. In July, 1953, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 53 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 36 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, latex emulsion for 4 per cent, and unclassified sales for 5 per cent.
