## SALES OF PAINTS VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 35 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 5,725,648$ in December, 1954, compared with $\$ 6,525,315$ in 1953. In December, 1954, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 43 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 45 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, latex emulsion for 8 per cent, and unclassified sales for 2 per cent。
