## SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$9,248,355 in July, 1954, compared with \$10,418,598 in 1953. In July, 1954, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 58 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 33 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, letex emulsion for 5 per cent, and unclassified sales for 2 per cent.
