SOAPS AND SYNTHETIC DETERGENTS

Factory shipments of soaps and synthetic detergents by principal Canadian producers were valued at \$5,024,072 during January, 1955. Soaps accounted for \$2,127,067 or 42 per cent of this total, while synthetic detergents accounted for \$2,897,005 or 58 per cent. The shipments for January, 1955, included 1,305,340 pounds of bar laundry and household soaps at \$217,284; 798,909 pounds of soap chips and flakes in household packages at \$128,163; 3,220,686 pounds of toilet soaps in bars at \$996, 115; and 2,932,712 pounds of soap powders in household packages at \$603,572. Shipments of synthetic detergents in household packages totalled 9,366,029 pounds at \$2,438,156 during the same period.
