## SOAPS AND SYNTHETIC DETERGENTS

Factory shipments of soaps and synthetic detergents by principa producers were valued at \$4,297,025 during December, 1955. Soaps accounted for \$1.610.703 or 37.5 per cent of this total, while synthetic detergents accounted for \$2,686,322 or 62.5 per cent. The shipments for December, 1955, included 1,335,675 pounds of bar laundry and household soaps at \$223,780; 1,515,442 pounds of soap chips and flakes in household packages at \$207,411; 2,217,863 pounds of toilet soaps in bars at \$652,706; and 1,993,365 pounds of soap powders in household packages at \$450,700. Shipments of solid synthetic detergents in household packages totalled 8,264,871 pounds at \$2,266,475; liquid synthetic detergents in household packages totalled 689,472 pounds Historical File at \$257,928 during the same period.
