Ger loading for the week ended July 8 th increased from 35,289 cars for the previous week to 40,469 care, but after adjustment for the holiday and seasonal variation the index number declined only fraction of point. from 64.96 to 64.18.

In the eastern division loading increased by 4.811 cars over the previous week and the index number rose from 58.03 to 61.86 . Merchandise increased by 1,916 cars, raising the index number from 69.87 to 74.71 . Coal howe an increase of 949 cars and cole of 67 cars and the 1 index mumbrs rose from 63.83 and 58.03 to 73.13 and 99.56 , respectively. pulp and paper increased by 357 cars, increasing the index number from 68.18 to 79.89 , and ore increased by 99 cars, raisire the index number fran 26.83 to 38.68 . LI other camodities showed sight increases except 11 vestccir which decreased by 18 cars.

Total loading in the western inion showed an increase over the previous weak of 369 care, but, after adjustment, the index number dropped from 80.52 to 69.05 . Grain and grain products showed a decrease of 574 car from the previous week, reducing the index number from 134.04 to 89.92 .001 increased by 114 cars and miscellaneous freight by 395 cars and the index numbers rome from 47.81 and 53.25 to 55.64 and 57.02 , respectively. Al though loadings showed 11 title ohange for coke, lumber, pripwood, pulp and paper, other forest product and merchandise, the index number was lowered for all of these commodities.
