REVENUE CAR LOADINGS FOR

Week ended August 2nd, 1924

Car loadings in Canada for the week ended August :2 were less than those of the previous week by 698 cars. Grain loading in the Western Division fell off 238 cars and decreased 342 cars in the East. Coal loading in the Eastern Division was less by 338 cars, pulpwood increased 27 cars, pulp and paper fell off 35 cars, while merchandise declined 22 cars, the total decline in the East being 762 cars, and the increase in the West 64 cars.

Compared with the corresponding week of 1923, car loadings were less by 2,554 cars.
