REVENUE CAR LOADINGS
FOR
WEEK ENDED NOVEMBER 14, 1925

The affect of the holiday on Thanksgiving, November 9 is apparent in the car loadings last week, particularly in the eastern division where the decrease from the previous week's loadings was 4,160 cars, the largest decreases as would be expected, being in merchandise, 2,007 cars, and in miscellaneous freight, 1,706 cars. With fair weather in the western division threshing continued and grain loading showed an increase of 1,393 cars, aggregating 17,061 cars which is the third heaviest week's loading this year. Merchandise and miscellaneous freight showed decreases also in the west but the total loadings were 544 cars above the previous week's. Total loadings for Canada were 3,624 cars less than during the previous week but were 10,050 cars above the corresponding week in 1924.
